**At Eisner Health, we work to address disparities, improve health outcomes and access to care across Los Angeles County, serving patients in over 194 zip codes.**

When people have regular access to affordable, integrative, and culturally competent health care, it results in better long-term health outcomes that directly correlate to increased education, career opportunities, and income.

Embedded in our mission is a commitment to serve all in our community, regardless of one's ability to pay. The majority of our patients live in urban neighborhoods that are

densely populated with large multi-generational families, challenged by high rates of chronic disease and shorter life expectancies. Eisner Health addresses these challenges and more. Our success is a result of focusing on the entire household, not just the individual patient.

We know that our patients' needs do not stop at health care. We connect patients and their families to social, legal, and educational services, treating all people with the dignity and care they deserve. ## Our History

On March 22, 1920, Eisner Health was founded as the **Anita M. Baldwin Hospital for Babies**.

Ms. Baldwin founded the hospital after losing her own twins shortly after birth. She took her tragedy and dedicated herself to supporting the health of mothers and babies, first occupying three beds on the campus of California Hospital. The hospital continued to grow, and by 1945, we opened the first preschool dental clinic in the western U.S. and oversaw 30 inpatient pediatric beds. In later years, our mission expanded from infants and children to adults, families, and seniors across their lifespan.

Over the last two decades, Eisner Health has expanded to twelve locations and enhanced our capacity to meet evolving community needs. With a transformative gift from the Eisner Foundation in 2002, our organization was renamed, and two years later, we received certification as a Federally Qualified Health Center. Our patients include our community's most vulnerable residents, and in the last few years, we have found new and innovative ways to care for them, including the introduction of telehealth services and mobile health.

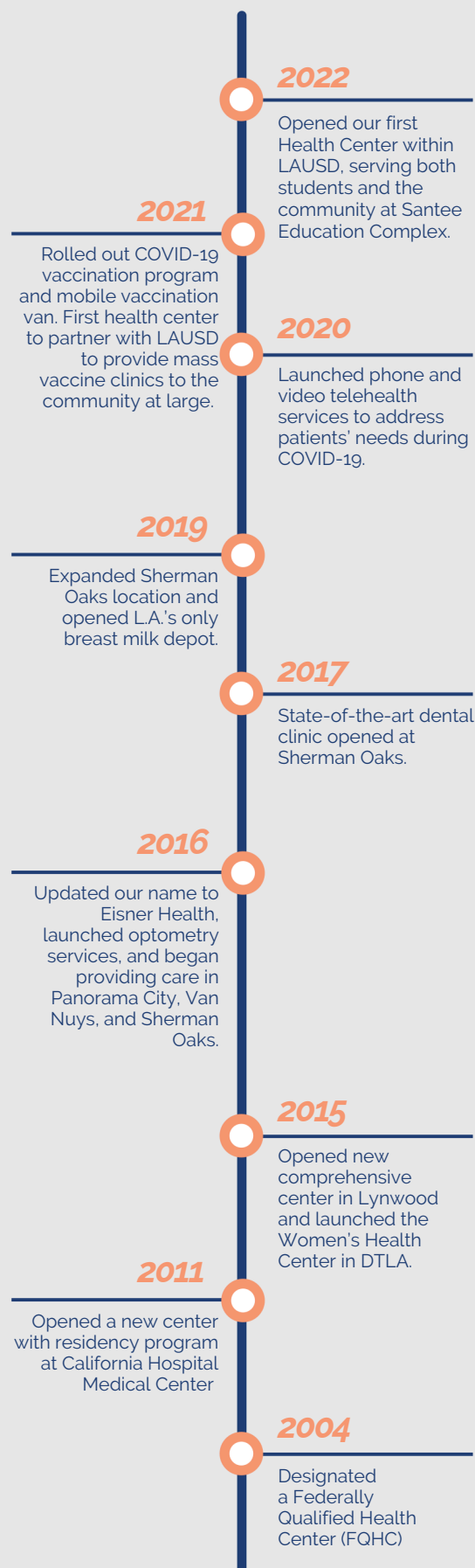

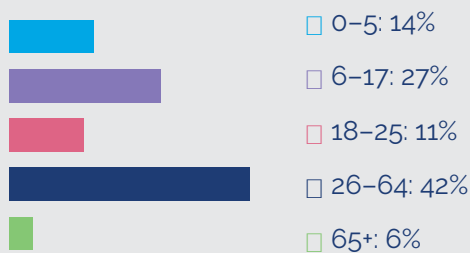

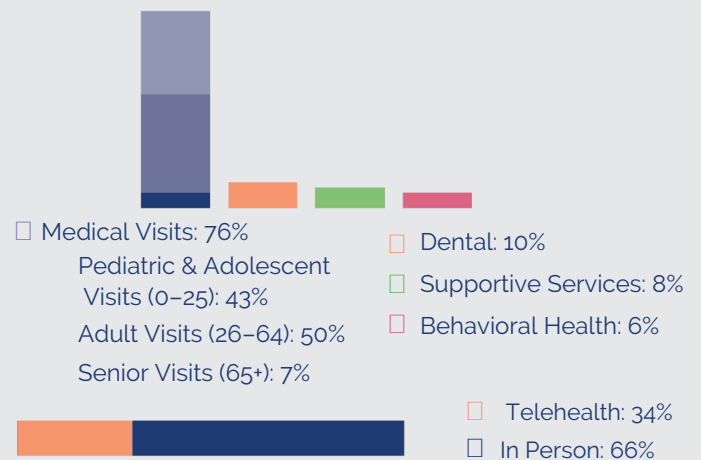

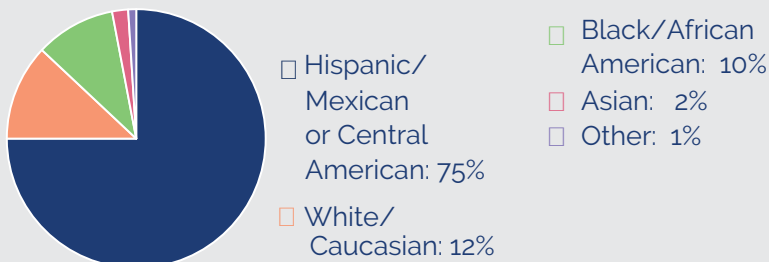

## Visit Types



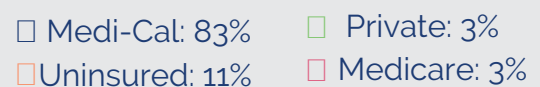
## Patients by Race/Ethnicity

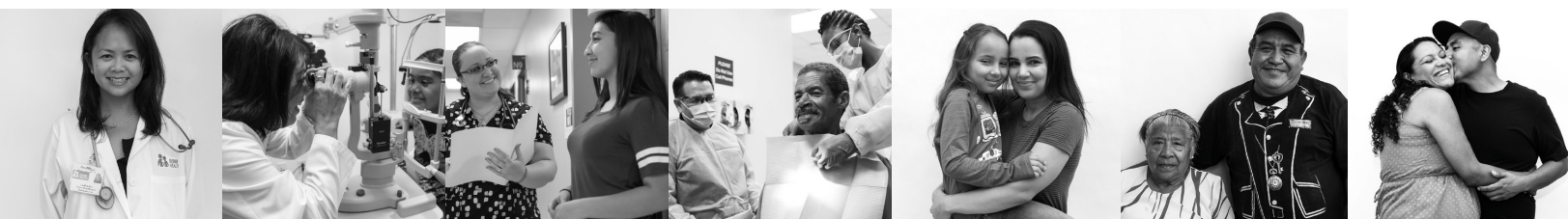
