Unique in Los Angeles: Eisner Health's Specialty Dental Services

We are proud to be the only Federally Qualified Health Center in Los Angeles County to provide orthodontic and cleft lip and palate treatment to our patients. To support patients who need these complicated treatments, the dental team collaborates with plastic surgeons, oral surgeons, and speech therapists from several different hospitals in the area.



More Than Medicine

At Eisner Health, we know true health goes beyond the exam room. That's why we offer a range of support services—connecting patients to resources, education, and care coordination that empower long-term well-being.



Classes That Empower

In 2024, we offered free classes and workshops to help patients and families take charge of their health, including Prenatal & Childbirth Prep, Diabetes Management, Parenting Support, Nutrition & Healthy Eating, Breastfeeding Classes, Stress Reduction & Mental Wellness, and more—all available in English and Spanish.



Community Connection

Our Patient Relations team helped us stay connected to the community by attending 62 health fairs and tabling events across Los Angeles in 2024—bringing resources, referrals, and care access directly to the people we serve.



Navigating Complex Needs

For patients facing chronic illness, housing insecurity, or mental health needs, our Care Coordinators and ECM team provide **one-on-one support** to connect them with services, navigate care, and remove barriers to better health.



Providing Nourishment and Support for Recovery

At 68, Mr. P faces ongoing health challenges due to the lasting effects of a stroke and other medical conditions. With his wife as his primary caregiver, accessing nutritious food was becoming increasingly difficult.

During a routine Health Risk Assessment, our Medical Care Coordinator identified Mr. P's need for food assistance and connected him with a program that provides Medically Tailored Meals. Just weeks later, Mr. P was thrilled to learn he qualified—he had already spoken with a dietitian and was set to receive his first delivery.

Now, nutritious meals arrive at his doorstep each week, easing his burden and supporting his health. With continued access to this vital resource, Mr. P has one less worry on his road to wellness.
